



Birdwatcher's Hat

A M O R E H O U S E O R I G I N A L



- Size:** Adult or child (child in parenthesis)
Yarn: 1 skein of Morehouse Merino Featherlight (or use sport-weight yarn double)
Needles: set of double-pointed #7 (or size to obtain gauge)
crochet hook
Gauge: 4 stitches = 1 inch over rib pattern

Cast on 76 (72) stitches. Join and work in rib pattern as follows: *purl 1, knit 1; rep from * to end of round. Work 48 (42) rounds in rib pattern. Next round: *knit 2 together; rep from * to end of round. Next round: *knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, yarn over; rep from * to end of round, ending round with knit 1, purl 1 (this round creates eyelet holes to thread cord through to gather top of hat). Next round: *knit 1, purl 1; rep from * to end of round. Repeat this last round total of 10 (8) more rounds. Bind off.

Crochet (or braid) cord about 24" long and thread through eyelet holes. Pull tight and tie ends into a bow.

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
