



Size: about 12" wide and 75" long
Yarn: 2 skeins of Morehouse Merino Lace (225 yards per skein)
Needles: #15
Gauge: not crucial and hard to measure with loose stitches

Scarf is knit diagonally.
Cast on 3 stitches and knit first row. Next: *knit first stitch twice (knit first stitch, but don't drop stitch off left-hand needle, now knit into same stitch again, this time through the back of stitch), then knit to end of row. Repeat from * until you have 54 stitches.

Start pattern (mark beginning of **Row 1** with a piece of different color yarn—that way you'll know where to work the increase).

Row 1 Knit first stitch twice (same as above), knit row to last 2 stitches, knit those 2 stitches together

Row 2 Knit

Repeat these 2 rows for 166 rows.
Decreases: *Knit row to last 2 stitches, knit those 2 stitches together. Repeat from * until you have 3 stitches left. Bind off.
