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Corner Hat

A MOREHOUSE ORIGINAL



- Size:** Adult
- Yarn:** 1 skein of Variegated Morehouse Merino 3-Strand
- Needles:** Set of double-pointed #5 or #6 (size to obtain gauge)
For bind-off, it is helpful to have an extra double-pointed needle (same size or smaller than the ones you are using for hat)
- Gauge:** 4½ stitches = 1 inch over stockinette stitch

Cast on 84. Join and knit to desired length of hat or until you have about 2 yards of yarn left.

Three tips: knit 14 stitches, then transfer the next 14 stitches onto the extra needle (just transfer stitches, don't knit them). Now put the two needles (the one with the first 14 stitches and the one with the 14 stitches you transferred) parallel to each other (right side facing out), and—using three-needle bind-off, bind off 13 stitches (How do you do three-needle bind-off? Knit the first stitch on needle closest to you together with first stitch on needle in back, then knit second stitch on needle closest to you together with second stitch on needle in back, then bind off regularly by lifting first stitch over second one. Continue this way, knitting two stitches together from front and back needle, then binding off.) You now have the one remaining stitch from bind-off in your right-hand needle. Knit the next 14 stitches. Then transfer the next 15 stitches onto empty needle. Now bind off 14 stitches using three-needle bind-off. Again, you'll have the one remaining stitch from bind-off on your right-hand needle. Knit the next 13 stitches. Put the final needle parallel to the needle you just knit, and bind off remaining 14 stitches using three-needle bind-off.

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
