



Diamond Point Stole

A MOREHOUSE ORIGINAL



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RED HOOK, NY

Yarn: 4 skeins of Morehouse Merino Lace

Needles: #7 or #8

Gauge: 16 stitches and 20 rows = 4 inches after blocking

Finished Size: 26" x 70"

Cast on 103 stitches. Knit 15 rows in stockinette stitch (purling row 1 and following odd rows, knit row 2 and following even rows), ending with a purl row.

Begin pattern: Row 1: Purl

Row 2: Knit

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: K3, *yo, k2tog; repeat from * to last 2 stitches, k2

Repeat these 6 pattern rows until you have about 25 yards of yarn left, ending with Row 6.

End with 15 rows in stockinette stitch (purling row 1 and following odd rows, knit row 2 and following even rows), ending with a purl row. Bind off loosely to match the cast-on.

Finishing your shawl: Darn in ends, or with the lace yarn you can also tie a square knot and cut the ends to 1/4" long. Block your shawl by washing in lukewarm water with a small amount of gentle soap (shampoo works well). Rinse with water the same temperature as the wash water and gently squeeze to remove water. Roll in a towel to remove excess water and stretch to final dimensions, training the stole to shape. You can stretch it on a bed, or stretching it out on a short-pile carpet also works well to hold the work in place while it dries.

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The sample is shown in Morehouse Merino Lace Natural White, with 60 pattern repeats.
