Here are the details for my swatch:

$$\boxed{} \text{ stitches} = \boxed{} \text{ inches}$$

A B

AND

$$\boxed{} \text{ rows} = \boxed{} \text{ inches}$$

D E

That means my gauge is:

Stitch gauge

A B C (AKA stitch gauge)

Row gauge

D E F (AKA row gauge)

I want my personally designed hand warmers to be this size:
