



CATWALK SCARF

A MOREHOUSE ORIGINAL

- Size:** about 10" x 70" after washing/blocking
Yarn: 2 skeins of Morehouse Merino Bulky (115 yards per skein)
Needle: US #19
Gauge: about 2 stitches = 1 inch over pattern as knit (will stretch after washing/blocking)

Cast on 17 stitches. Purl first row, then start with Fisherman Rib Pattern (see at left). Work in pattern until you have about 2 yards of yarn left, ending with Row 2 of pattern. Bind off loosely in next row and work row as follows (binding off stitches as you work row): slip first stitch, *knit 1 stitch, purl 1 stitch, repeat from * ending row with 2 knit stitches.

CATWALK THROW

- Size:** about 60" wide after washing/blocking
Yarn: 10-12 skeins of Morehouse Merino Bulky (115 yards per skein)
Needle: circular US #19

Cast on 93 stitches and purl first row. Then work in Fisherman Rib Pattern to desired length—55" to 65", ending with Row 2 of pattern. Work bind-off row same as for Scarf (see above).


Finishing:

(Don't skip this step – it will give you the finished size of Scarf and Throw.) Soak Scarf or Throw in warm water for a few minutes. Add some mild soap to water. Rinse in same temperature water, then squeeze out as much water as possible (or spin dry in washing machine – no rinsing, just spin cycle); then lay Scarf or Throw flat to dry, stretching it to its maximum size.

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FISHERMAN RIB PATTERN

- Row 1:** slip first stitch as if to purl stitch with yarn in front, *knit 1 stitch, knit 1 stitch into stitch below (see illustration) ; repeat from * to last 2 stitches, knit those 2 stitches.
Row 2: slip first stitch (same as in Row 1), *knit 1 stitch into stitch below, knit 1; repeat from * to end of row.



This illustration shows stockinette stitch pattern because it is easier to illustrate knitting into stitch below on an all-knit surface.
