



Size About 3" each
Yarn Worsted weight
Needles Set of double-pointed #4 or #5
Patterns **Rib pattern:** *knit 1 stitch, purl 1 stitch; repeat from * to end of round. **Stockinette pattern:** knit each round if worked in the round; knit on right side, purl on wrong side, if worked back and forth.

SOCK Cast on 16 stitches (4 stitches per needle). Join and work 5 rounds in rib pattern. Next, knit 6 rounds. Start heel: knit stitches on first needle, turn and purl back (on inside of sock) to beginning of round, then purl stitches on fourth needle. Combine stitches from first and fourth needle on one needle. Continue working on these 8 stitches for heel. Work a total of 10 rows in stockinette stitch pattern. Next row (right side row) knit 5 stitches, knit the next 2 stitches together; turn and purl 3 stitches, purl the next 2 stitches together. Turn and knit 3 stitches, knit the next 2 stitches together; turn and purl 3 stitches, purl the next 2 stitches together—you'll have 4 stitches left. Next row: knit 2 stitches and start with new needle and knit the next 2 stitches. Now pick up 6 stitches along heel side (1 stitch per 2 rows and 1 additional stitch between heel and next needle. Next, knit stitches on needle 2 and 3. Pick up 6 stitches again along other side of heel and add the 2 stitches remaining to needle 4. You now have 8 stitches on needle 1 and 4; and 4 stitches each on needle 2 and 3. *Knit 1 round. Next round: knit stitches on needle 1 to last 2 stitches, knit those 2 stitches together, knit stitches on needle 2 and 3, then knit the first 2 stitches on needle 4 together, then knit remaining stitches. Repeat from * until you have 16 stitches left. Knit 6 rounds. Next round: *knit 1 stitch, knit 2 stitches together; repeat from * to end of round

(knit last stitch). Knit 1 round. Next round: *knit 2 stitches together; repeat from * to end of round. Pull yarn through remaining stitches. On back of sock, crochet or braid little loop for hanging.

HAT Cast on 20 stitches. Join and work 3 rounds in rib pattern. Knit the next 4 rounds. Next round: *knit 3 stitches, knit 2 stitches together; repeat from * to end of round. Knit 4 rounds. Next round: *knit 2 stitches, knit 2 stitches together; repeat from * to end of round. Knit 3 rounds. Next round: *Knit 1, knit 2 together; repeat from * to end of round. Knit 2 rounds. Next round: *knit 2 together; repeat from * to end of round. Pull yarn through remaining stitches. Tassel: wrap yarn around a ruler (or similar object about 1 wide) 25 times. Tie knot around wraps at one end (use yarn double). Then cut open loops at other end. Trim tassel and attach to tip of hat.



SWEATER Cast on 24 stitches. Join and work 4 rounds in rib pattern. Knit 5 more rounds. Divide stitches in half—12 stitches for front and 12 for back. Continue on front (the first 12 stitches) and work back and forth on these 12 stitches. Work 10 rows in stockinette stitch. Leave stitches on needle and work back to same length. Bind off shoulders from front and back together using three-needle bind off (how? turn sweater inside out and put the needles from front and back parallel to each other and, starting at shoulder, knit first stitch from front together with first stitch from back, knit second stitch from front together with second stitch from back, then bind off first stitch, etc.) Bind off 3 stitches total at each shoulder. Use remaining middle stitches for collar: work 9 rounds in rib pattern. Bind off loosely. Sleeves: pick up 12 stitches around armhole (right side facing out, starting at armhole); pick up 1 stitch per 2 rows, plus 1 additional stitch at shoulder and at armhole position. Knit 10 rounds. Finish with 4 rounds in rib pattern. Bind off. Repeat for other sleeve.



MITTENS Cast on 16 stitches. Join and work 5 rounds in rib pattern. Knit 1 round. Thumb gusset: knit 1 stitch, place first marker, increase 1 (increase by picking up yarn between stitches and knitting through back of loop), knit 1, increase 1, place second marker, knit to end of round. Knit 1 round. Repeat these 2 rounds until you have 7 stitches between markers. Next round: knit 1, put the next 7 stitches on small stitch holder (paper clip will also work) and knit to end of round—pull yarn tight after first stitch. Knit 8 rounds. Next round: *knit 1, knit 2 together; repeat from * to end of round. Knit 1 round. Next round: *knit 2 together; repeat from * to end of round. Pull yarn through remaining stitches. Thumb: put 7 stitches on 3 needles, pick up 1 stitch between first and last stitch. Knit 5 rounds. Next round: *knit 2 stitches together; repeat from * to end of round. Pull yarn through stitches. Attach mittens to each other by crocheting a 5" string.

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
