



**Size:** approximately 25" in circumference and 7" tall

**Yarn:** 1 skein of Morehouse Merino Bulky

**Needles:** DPN or circular (16" or 24")  
US #11 or #13 (or size to obtain gauge)

**Gauge:** 12 stitches = 4"

**Cast on** 74 stitches and join to knit in the round, being careful not to twist.

**Begin pattern:**

Knit 3 rounds. Purl 2 rounds.

Repeat pattern until you've got about 4 yards of yarn left. (For a symmetric cowl, end with 2 or 3 knit rounds.)

**Bind off:**

Use a technique stretchy enough to match your cast-on.

*Here's a great one: knit the first stitch, then \*knit 1 stitch, then insert your left needle into the back of both stitches (your needles will be positioned as if to knit) and knit the 2 stitches together.*

*Repeat from \* until you have one stitch remaining, and pull the yarn through that last stitch.*

Darn in ends and wear well!

**Blocking/Washing:**

This last step helps the stitches relax and even out. Simply fill a bowl with lukewarm water and a dash of gentle soap (we like Palmolive or shampoo). Submerge your project. Let it soak for a few minutes and then rinse in water the same temperature as the wash water. Gently squeeze out as much water as you can, then roll in a towel to remove excess moisture. Lay flat to dry, shaping as needed.
